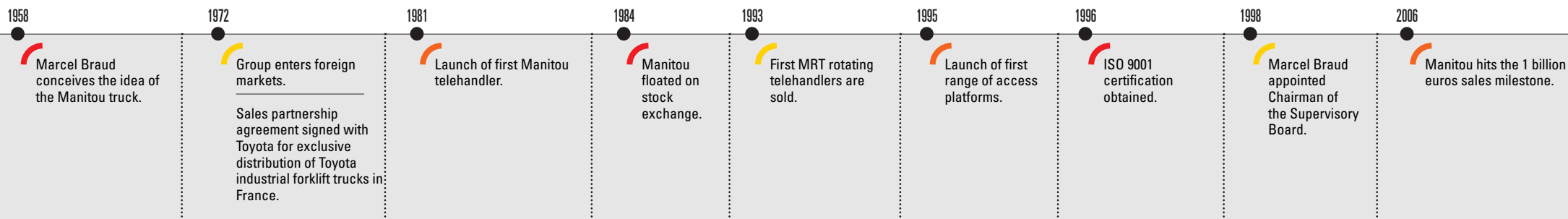
Handling your world

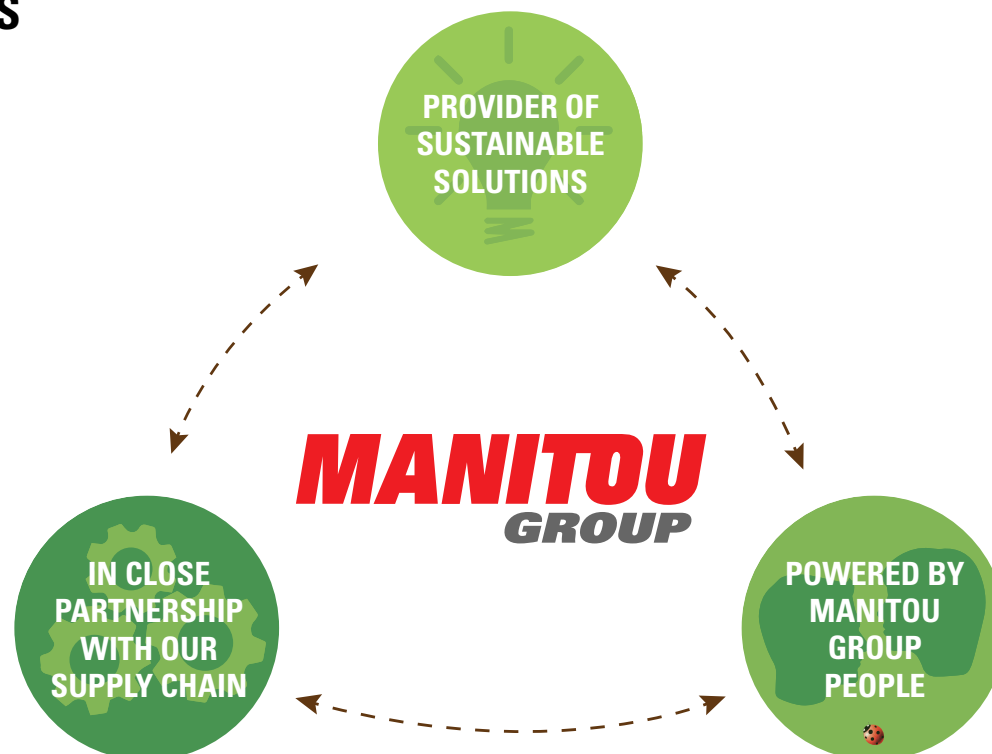

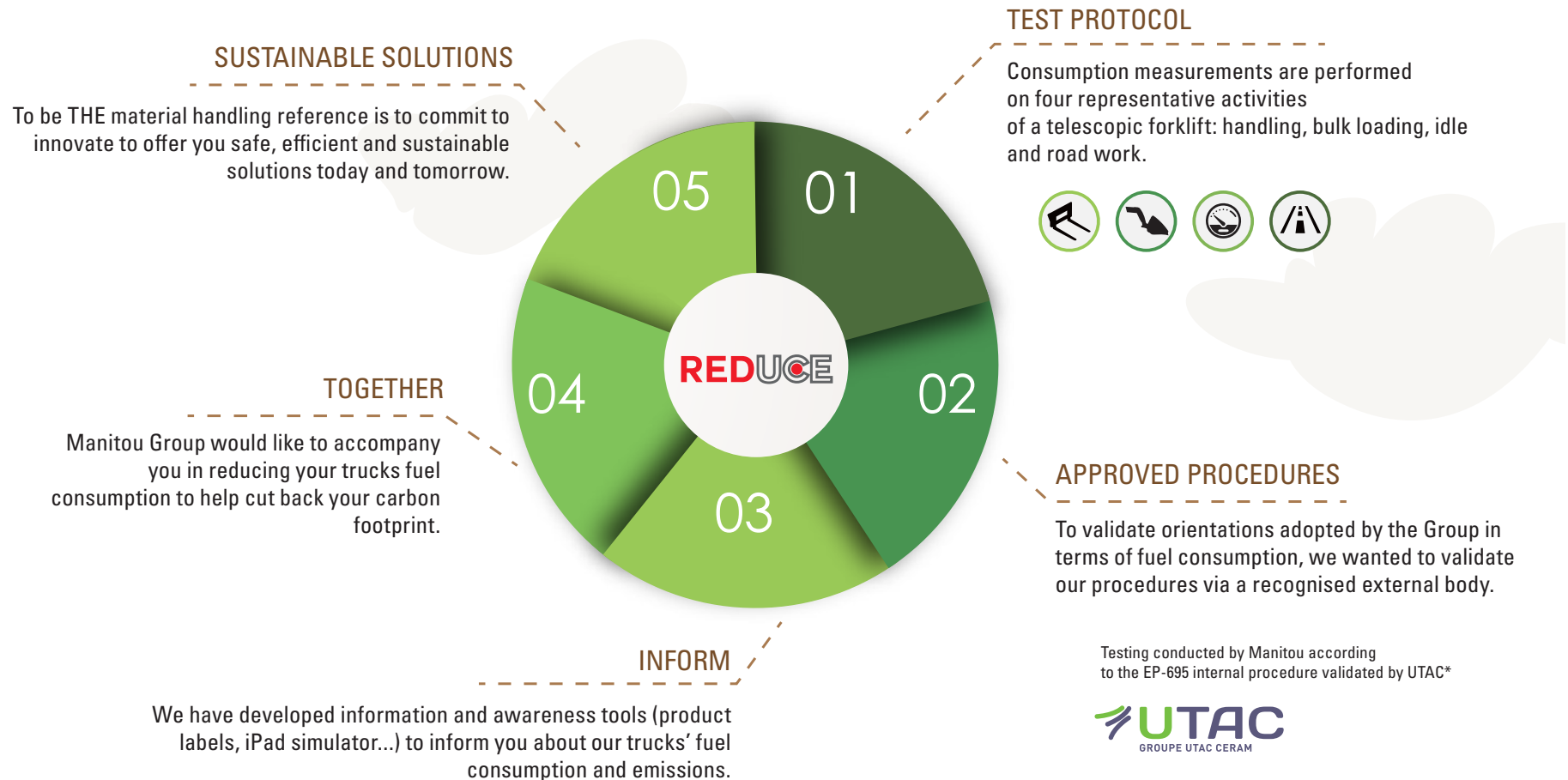
